

Applying for Entry to the Master Degree Programme Electrical and Microsystems Engineering

The course is offered subject to sufficient demand. It is required to cover 3 semesters of full-time study. It is possible to study the course entirely in German or English language.

1. Admission Requirements

- a) Applicants must have successfully completed a relevant technical or natural science course (e.g. electrical engineering, mechatronics or microsystems technology), achieving the minimum grade "good"(2,5) or better with at least 180 Credit Points or
- b) they must have successfully completed an equivalent study degree program being under the best 51% of the cohort.

2. Admission Procedure

Applications

Consideration can only be given to applications for admission to OTH Regensburg, which are submitted within the application period and in the correct form.

Applications should be made to the Admissions and Organization Office not to the Examination Board or respective faculty. Please use the online application form that can be retrieved in the University Portal under the following link:

Application periods, both for online application and submission of hard copies:

Winter semester: 01.05.-15.06.

Summer semester: 15.11.-15.01.

Applications made outside these periods cannot be considered.

3. Submission of documents

3.1 Language Requirements

Applicants whose native language is not German or English shall provide evidence of sufficient German or English proficiency in spoken and written language using the certificates recognized by OTH Regensburg.

Proficiency in English can be shown by either submitting a current

- IELTS-Certificate with an overall grade of at least 5, or
- TOEFL-Certificate having achieved at least 400 points in the „Paper-based test“ or a minimum of 72 points in the „Internet-based test“
- Cambridge Certificate, level B 2
- TELC, level B 2

Accepted certificates of German language proficiency are:

- DSH 1 or TestDaF (with TND 3 in all parts)
- Goethe Zertifikat, telc Zertifikat (minimum C 1)
- DSD Zeugnis (Step II with level B2 in all examination parts)
- DSP II-Zeugnis (Step II with level C1)

3.2 Admission documents

Copies of documents are acceptable. However external applicants of other universities are required to submit authenticated first-degree diplomas (authentications can be made after arrival in Germany).

Please note that only the following documents will be considered!

- First degree diploma * (e.g. Bachelor certificate)
- Uni-assist Evaluation Report (=VPD) (only necessary in case you studied the first degree at a foreign university), the evaluation report needs to have the logo of uni-assist in the header
- De-registration certificate * (only necessary in case you studied the first degree in Germany)
- Evidence of post-graduate career experience (only if applicable)
- Range of percentage (only necessary in case your final grade is not 2.5 or better)
- Language certificate (see accepted certificates above)
- Printed and signed data-control sheet from the University Portal
- Curriculum vitae (resume)
- 6-month internship certificate** (internship semester will be accepted)

* These documents can be produced on enrolment if they are not available when the application is made.

** This document can be produced until the end of the second semester if it is not available when the application is made.
